

Grievance redressal mechanism for faculty, staff and students

For Family:

The members of the faculty are authorized to make the representations to the Principal or the Grievance redressal committee through the head of the department. The Committee and the Principal shall then make enquiries regarding the grievances and shall make recommendations to redressal of the same. The same shall be referred to the board of governors, if needed. The grievance redressal committee consists of the senior most professors of the institute as members by rotation in the seniority order for a term of 3 years.

For Students:

The students shall be authorized to make their representations to the heads of various sections like mess supervisors, wardens, controller of examinations, registrars and student's welfare officer through the academic head of department. The students may approach to the Principal in case of major grievance for necessary action.

For Staff:

The staff grievance shall be referred to the grievance redressal committee or the Principal through the head of the department. The committee/ Principal enquire about the grievances and shall make recommendations to redress the same to the concerned heads like Registrar, Administrative Officer and Establishment section in-charge.

If needed it is also brought to the notice of Chairman of the trust/governing council.
